

Accelerate Your Graduate Degree!


VSU's College of Humanities and Social Sciences offers an Accelerated Undergraduate-to-Graduate track in many of our Bachelor's degrees that enables high-achieving undergraduates to take 12 hours of courses (depending on the program) that can be dual counted for both Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree at VSU. Often called "4+1," this program significantly shortens the time needed to complete a graduate degree.

In History, for example, undergraduates take 9 hours of courses that can be dual counted for their Bachelor of Arts degree and for their Master of Arts Degree; students who participate in this program as undergraduates only take 21 more hours of graduate courses to earn A.M. Degree in History at VSU.

4+1 programs enable undergraduates to complete almost of a graduate degree by the time they finish a Bachelor's degree.
