



If You Discover Fire or Smoke Remember: R.A.C.E.



Rescue: Help anyone in immediate danger.

A

Alarm: Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station.

C

Contain: Close all doors to confine smoke and fire.

Extinguish/Evacuate: If the fire is small, and you have been trained in fire extinguisher use, you can attempt to extinguish a fire. If you are not trained, evacuate the building immediately.



E

If You Catch Fire, Do Not Run!

a. Stop, Drop, and Roll.

b. Call 911.

Evacuation Reminders

- If leaving a room, feel the door with the back of your hand
- Do not return to your area for personal belongings
- If smoke is present, stay low. The best quality air is near the floor.
- Use the stairway or horizontal exit to evacuate.
- DO NOT USE ELEVATORS!
- Consider individuals with disabilities who may need assistance
- Individuals with disabilities should exit to the nearest safe area
