



the affected area with water for 15 minutes, then as soon as possible notify University Police of a spill. University Police will arrange for emergency medical services to be sent to the spill area.

- Do not attempt to clean up a spill unless you are trained and have the proper protective equipment for cleanup.
- Evacuate the area when there is a danger of harmful or flammable vapors.
- Notify others in your immediate area to evacuate. Consider persons who may need assistance evacuating.
- Initiate the fire alarm when necessary.

Hazardous Material Spills

- Always evacuate in a calm and orderly manner to a safe predetermined location. Notify University Police of any missing persons and where they were last seen.
- To increase ventilation to the affected area, call HVAC at Plant Operations (5875) for assistance.
- If possible, control access to the affected area by closing doors.
- Check those involved for adverse medical symptoms (shortness of breath, fainting, etc.) and request immediate medical attention as appropriate.
- Evacuees should remain in the designated safe area until University Police indicate it is safe to return to the affected area.
